For every test conducted in a low-income country, more than 100 are being conducted in high-income countries.*

Track and contain COVID-19 outbreaks



Diagnose and provide appropriate treatment to patients



Detect and sequence more virulent and potentially more deadly variants that are emerging



Measure the efficacy of vaccines against existing and new strains of COVID-19
