

Pooled Procurement Mechanism Antimalarial Medicines Forecast for calendar year 2021

Below is an indicative forecast for both Pooled Procurement Mechanism (PPM) and Co-payment Mechanism (CPM) volumes for 2021, based on information available as of 25 February 2021.
