

Juan Pablo Gutierrez Chair, Independent Evaluation Panel



Juan Pablo Gutierrez serves as Professor at the National Autonomous University of Mexico's Center for Policy, Population & Health Research within the School of Medicine. His research focuses on evaluating social programs and policies, universal health coverage, health care accessibility, and health inequalities.

Gutierrez holds a BSc in Nutrition from the Autonomous Metropolitan University, an MSc in Health Economics from CIDE, and a PhD in Public Health and Policy from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. This interdisciplinary background informs his comprehensive approach to public health research and evaluation.

Gutierrez has led evaluations of social and health programs across multiple countries, including Mexico, Ecuador, Guatemala, the Dominican Republic, Honduras, Rwanda and India. His expertise extends to designing and implementing population-based health and evaluation surveys in both household and facility settings.

His leadership in global health is reflected in his service on prestigious committees, including the Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations (CEPI) Independent Evaluation Committee for the CEPI 2.0 Mid-term Review, the Gavi Evaluation Advisory Committee, and the World Health Organization Working Group on Monitoring, Evaluation and Research for Neglected Tropical Diseases. He also contributes to the Advisory Group of the Global Evaluation and Monitoring Network for Health. In recognition of his contributions, he has been elected to both the Mexican National Academy of Medicine and the Mexican Academy of Sciences.

Gutierrez has published extensively, with over 100 peer-reviewed journal articles, multiple book chapters, and influential reports in the fields of evaluation, public health, and policy research.
