Mark Edington has led the Grant Management Division of the Global Fund since 2011. He oversees investments in HIV, TB, malaria and health systems through grants to more than 100 countries, managed by six departments within the division.

Edington started his career as a chartered accountant and management consultant at PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC). He then held a variety of headquarters and field positions, both management and technical, with Save the Children US. He also served as Senior Vice President for International Programs; in this role, Edington led program streams that included health and a dedicated HIV and AIDS department. He joined the Global Fund from Save the Children International, where he served as the International Program Director.

Edington has a degree in German and Italian from the University of London.
