

Privacy Statement for Collection of Stakeholder Input to Inform the Development of the Global Fund's Post-2022 Strategy (*Feedback on Post-2022 Strategy*)

The Global Fund is committed to respecting the dignity and privacy of people, while balancing such rights with the Global Fund values of transparency and accountability and the ability of the Global Fund to carry out its mission.

1. When does this privacy statement apply?

This privacy statement explains how we collect and use personal information when you provide *Feedback on the Post-2022 Strategy*. It also explains the choices and rights available to you. The Global Fund will does not ask for, and you should not disclose, any personal information that identifies, or could be used to identify, any individual minor in connection with *Feedback on Post-2020 Strategy*.

2. What information will be collected about me and how will it be used?

The Global Fund will process personal information you provide on the basis of your consent; in this case to collect *Feedback on the Post-2022 Strategy*. This means the Global Fund has an interest in collecting information from stakeholders to inform the development of Global Fund's post-2022 strategy.

The information we collect about you will be limited to the following:

- Name (optional)
- E-mail (optional)
- Stakeholder type (optional) and includes, but is not limited to, the following categories:
 - Civil Society, Communities, Country Coordinating Mechanism, Donor, Global Fund Board or Committee Member, Implementer (e.g. Principal Recipient, Sub-Recipient), Local Fund Agent, Multilateral or Bilateral Organization, Parliamentarian/ Government Official/ Lawmaker, Technical Expert, Technical Review Panel Member, TERG Member, and Other as provided by the stakeholder.
- Geographical location (optional)

The survey will be conducted via Microsoft Forms. This means that the information you provide about yourself will be available to Microsoft Corporation through Microsoft Forms in the United States. The information about you will not be shared with any other person or entity outside the Global Fund.

3. How long will the Global Fund keep my information?

We will retain your information for 24 months.

4. How does the Global Fund protect my information?

The data is stored securely on Microsoft Forms created under the Global Fund Strategy Development account and is only accessed for purposes of obtaining feedback to inform the development of the Post-2022 Strategy

by the Strategy and Policy Hub at the Global Fund Secretariat. Responders can ask for their information to be deleted at any time.

5. What if I don't wish to provide my information?

You may still provide feedback, even if you do not wish to provide your name, email address, stakeholder type or geographical.

6. Whom should I contact if I have questions about my personal information?

You may request at any time that your personal information be corrected or deleted in connection with *Feedback on the Post-2020 Strategy*. We invite you to contact personaldataprotection@theglobalfund.org if you have questions about your personal information.

For your protection, we will need to verify your identity before implementing your request.

We will endeavor to respond to your request as soon as reasonably practicable. In some cases, we may need to retain certain information where important public interests require, such as the safety and security of individuals; the rights and freedoms of others; the integrity of audit, investigation, arbitral or judicial processes; and/or recordkeeping or legal purposes.

7. Privileges and immunities

Nothing in or related to this privacy statement may be construed as a waiver, express or implied, of the privileges and immunities accorded to the Global Fund under international law, including international customary law, any international conventions, treaties or agreements, or any national laws.
