Adda Faye has served as Chief Financial Officer of the Global Fund since June 2020, leading the Finance and Administration Division. She provides organization-wide oversight of the Global Fund's financial management and administrative functions, including stewardship of approximately US\$22 billion in assets and up to US\$4 billion in annual disbursements. Faye plays a pivotal role in safeguarding donor resources and leading financial strategies that integrate uncertainties and agility to enable organizational performance, while ensuring the adequacy and effectiveness of internal controls and financial governance frameworks.

Faye brings over 20 years of experience in strategic financial management within multilateral and public-sector environments. She began her career as an analyst at the Gambian Ministry of Finance, working on public enterprise performance under the divestiture program, and later joined UNESCO in Paris as a financial analyst through the Young Professionals Programme.

Faye studied finance and economics at New Jersey City University and holds a master's degree in financial aspects of decision management from the University of Bedfordshire. She has also completed an advanced management and leadership course at the Saïd Business School at the University of Oxford.
